

3 DAYS TRAINING ON MENTORING SKILLS AND USE OF RESOURCE CENTER MATERIALS

Children's Global Network Pakistan in collaboration with Save the Children Quetta conducted a 3 days training for lead teachers and education field staff on 21st to 23rd December, 2010. This training was organized for lead teachers who are assigned to monitor Save the Children partner schools established in afghan camps in Balochistan province. The training was focused to enhance the capacities of participants regarding mentoring skills and use of resource center materials.

Two trainers Mr. Abid Hussain and Mr. Shahid Naseem from CGN-P conducted this training in Pushtu language linked to Afghan curriculum. During training the participants were briefed on their new role and job, demands of new role from lead trainers, use of resource center materials creating link with Afghan curriculum. The participants were also introduced with the philosophy of interactive child centered teaching learning methodology and some innovative techniques that are universal and support the educationists and teachers in creating child centered environment while working with students.

CGN-P developed a resource manual to make strengthen the concepts and knowledge of the lead teachers who participated in training. The contents of the manual are discussed, practiced and demonstrated with the lead participants during their training. We are hopeful that this initiative would enhance the capacities of participants and finally it would contribute in promoting the quality education in afghan camps schools.
